**LIST OF CANDIDATES  
SNOQUALMIE TRIBAL ELECTION  
April 12, 2010**

The following list of candidates has been accepted by the Snoqualmie Tribal Administrator as of March 22, 2010. All candidates turned in notices of intent to run for office by the required date. The administrator has consulted proper tribal authorities who have confirmed that these individuals are:

- Enrolled member of the Tribe for at least three years as of April 12, 2010 and not banished by the Tribe.
- If they are running for Chairperson, they have served at least one full term on the Tribal Council previously.
- They are of at least one-eighth blood quantum, and not honorary or adopted members.
- They are not employees of a wholly owned subsidiary of the Tribe.
- They have not been convicted of any tribal felony for the past seven years.

The tribal election law also requires that Criminal Background Checks be performed on all candidates to determine that they have not been convicted of any felony in the United States in the last seven years. As of this mailing, these background checks have not been completed. If any candidate is disqualified because they fail to meet this requirement, they will be noticed prior to the election date.
